FACILITY TERMS AND CONDITIONS - Facility use outside the following terms and conditions deems unauthorised access to Maydale Reserve - Horsham Showgrounds and the Horsham Agricultural Society reserves the right to request users to vacate the premises, without further consultation.

It is compulsory for all users of the Maydale Reserve - Horsham Showgrounds facilities (stables & camping) to have a membership/facility \$15 fee per exhibit.

It is compulsory for *all visitors* with horses (those not participating but familiarising their horses) to pay facility fee of \$15

The Maydale Reserve is a popular indoor and outdoor events centre for the community. It hosts a variety of events, expos and show throughout the year and celebrates many wedding ceremonies and receptions. Therefore access to stabling and camping, can be limited outside of show season.

STABLES

Stables can only be booked online via www.nominate.com.au. Loose boxes for overnight accommodation for horses are limited and always under considerable pressure. Reservations will only be accepted via the Nominate website (see under the "Stables" section). The Horsham Agricultural Society reserves the right to retain bond monies for boxes left unclean and to allocate boxes according to size of the horse/galloway/pony. A limited number of stallion boxes are available for use but priority is given to stallions. However, each year there is a high demand for the Stallion Boxes. If you book these stables and are found to have booked for a mare or gelding, you agree to forfeit or accept another stable (if available) as STALLIONS will have priority. Competitors need to be aware that stallion boxes WILL be reallocated to stallions should the need arise. Our Society cannot guarantee any accommodation; therefore, you book on the understanding that you arrange your own care of your horses if necessary.

STABLE RATES

- \$15 per single stable per night
- \$30.00 Compulsory bond per stable cleaning deposit. This money is refunded once the stable has been checked off by a Horsham Ag Society staff member.

STRAW

- Straw bales at \$8 inc GST, will be delivered to the allocated stable as per the booking form. This year there is limited straw, so it will be first in best dressed.

CAMPING & PARKING

All camping must be booked online through www.nominate.com.au. Allocated sites are on a first in best dressed situation.

- Camping is charged at \$16.50 per day (powered site) or \$11 per day up (unpowered site)
- All campers must present to the office upon arrival to the Horsham Showgrounds to check in. QR Codes will be posted in toilets & showers if arriving out of office hours. Checking in is essential each time you return to the showgrounds.
- A canteen will be operating for breakfast and lunch til the end of the Show. Gluten free & vegetarian options available.

CAMPING & PARKING

- Bookings for camping and stabling pertaining to the Horsham Horse Show through Nominate will close following the show.
- Powered Camping \$16.50 per night.
- Unpowered Camping \$11 per night.
- Short term horse float parking during Horsham Horse Show is free.
- Long term horse float parking including and outside Horsham Horse Show dates up to 7 days is \$25.
- Long term horse float parking outside of Horsham Horse Show dates but not prior to, will attract a fee of \$5.50 per night.

MEASURING

Measuring is conducted from 8.00am to 9.30am prior to commencement of judging.

Official Measurer: TBC

Current height certificates from VAS Ltd, RASV, EA & SHC will be accepted

"Hereunder is set out the regulations relating to the measuring of horses and ponies in classes where height is specified. That height certificate issued by Royal Agricultural Society of Victoria and the Equestrian Victoria Inc. are duly recognised by the Show Society. All horse and ponies must be exhibited in accordance with the current height certification issued by these respective organisations. Horses and ponies without a current height certificate must be measured by the appointed measurer at the show, prior to being exhibited in a class where height is specified." When measuring a horse or pony, an allowance of 3/8 of an inch for shoes may be made at the direction of the measurer.

If the judge entertains a doubt as to the correctness of a height certificate, he/she has the power to order the exhibit to be re-measured. In such as case the Steward shall accompany the exhibit to the measurer and supervise the re-measuring.

This Show will be conducted strictly under EA rules. Competitors in all classes are to be suitable attired. Prize winners must leave the ring, as directed, after receiving awards.

REGULATIONS (to be read in conjunction with General Regulations)

1. Entries will only be received subject to the rules and regulations of the Society and the decisions of the Committee. All exhibits must be a bona fide property if the exhibitor or held by the exhibitor under a written lease recognised by the Society at the time of entry.
2. Every exhibitor or competitor shall be bound by and observe the decisions and directions of the Society.
3. The Society reserves the right to reject at any time any entry or prohibit any persons or animals from competition in any class.
4. The Society's Veterinary Surgeon's decision regarding age shall be final.
5. No ribbons will be permitted on exhibitors except those won during the show.
6. In competitions, competitors under the age of 21 years must supply proof of age with entry. Proof of age will be accepted in the form of birth certificate, extract of birth entry, statutory declaration by either parent, baptismal certificate or head teacher's certificate.
7. Owners entering their horses or ponies do so entirely at their own risk and it is a condition of entry that no liability of any kind attaches itself to the Society, its officials or members in any respect whatsoever, other than the liability for refund of entry fee in the event of abandonment of any competitions.

8. All events to be held and run over courses and obstacles as the Society may decide.
9. Animals must be haltered in the ring.
10. EA random swabbing procedures may be imposed by the Society and also reserves the right to scan for microchip proof of identity of any exhibit. **A \$3 swabbing fee per horse entry will be charged.**
11. Exhibits must be exhibited as Open or Show Hunters not both – competitors contravening this rule will be eliminated.
12. Protests – to be lodged with deposit of \$100, in writing, to the show office. **NO OTHER FORM OF PROTESTS WILL BE CONSIDERED**
13. Refunds will not be given for scratching's unless a valid Veterinary (horse) or Medical Certificate (inc. Covid related for competitor) is provided within 7 days of the show and will only be given less an administration fee of \$10.

V.A.S. GOOD HANDS CHALLENGE TROPHY

Open to girls and boys who have won a 'Good Hands' competition at a local show

Background

The V.A.S. Saddle Horse Championships began in 1996. The V.A.S. Committee determined to introduce an event that would not only showcase champion horses and riders from across country Victoria, but in turn increase exhibitor numbers at country shows.

The 'Best of the Best' event has grown steadily and is now recognised as a 'competitor friendly Championships'. The V.A.S. Good Hands Challenge Trophy is held during the Saddle Horse Championships The Championships will again be held at the Prince of Wales Showgrounds in Bendigo.

V.A.S. SADDLE HORSE CHAMPIONSHIPS

Due to the current pandemic, further information is not yet available. Please refer to the V.A.S. website.

Qualifications

The minimum qualification for the V.A.S. Saddle Horse Championships is that the exhibitor has attended V.A.S. affiliated shows between January 2022 and December 2021. Refer to V.A.S. Ltd website for details.

Championships will include qualifications from 1st January 2022 to 2nd December 2022.

All rules and regulations will be included with the entry form. The V.A.S. Saddle Horse Committee advises that the entry form for the V.A.S. Saddle Horse Championships will be available in late September.

GOOD HANDS CHALLENGE TROPHY

Rules and Regulations – Local Show

1. The VAS Good Hands Challenge Trophy is conducted at the VAS Saddle Horse Championships
2. The VAS Good Hands Challenge Trophy is open to boys and girls aged 10 years and under 15 years on the day of the local Show/field day
3. All VAS affiliated Shows/field days are invited to hold the qualifying competitions. Show societies are encouraged to run one class at the local Show which includes girls and boys
4. The competitors shall be judged solely on their riding ability - mount, saddlery or costume will not be taken into account
5. Special attention will be paid to hands and seat, general management and control of the horse or pony
6. Competitors must ride using an ordinary snaffle, single jointed in the centre. The mouthpiece must be smooth and made of the same type of metal, with or without a cavesson on the noseband
7. A gear check may take place
8. Please note: straight bar snaffle, drop nosebands, whips and spurs are not allowed.

Rules and Regulations – State Final

1. The VAS Good Hands Challenge Trophy is conducted at the VAS Saddle Horse Championships as one class for girls and boys
2. No entry fee will be charged but the entrant must fill out VAS Saddle Horse Championships entry form.
3. The VAS 'Good Hands Challenge Trophy' Competition shall be judged on the same basis as the qualifying competitions, but the Judge shall require: Five Finalists to execute a figure 8 at a canter, ride away from the Judge, return at a slow canter, stop at the Judge's signal and back
4. Equipment used must be as for the Qualifying Competition as specified above
5. The names of the winner will be engraved on the perpetual trophy
6. The winners of the 'Good Hands Challenge Trophy' will be eligible to compete in future years, subject to the age of the competitor
7. VAS Ltd may, at its discretion, vary the conditions governing the qualifying and Championship Competitions

Winner: Receives VAS Ltd State Final Trophy Top 5: Sashes and Prize Pack sponsored by State sponsor Sporthorse Saddlery

2021/21 OFF THE TRACK RIDDEN SERIES – QUALIFIER REGULATIONS

1. **Open to any thoroughbred horse bred to race that has been stud book registered, either domestically with the Australian Stud Book or Internationally that are 4 years and over and over 14.2 hands high. Registrations will be checked by V.A.S. office.**
2. Racing name to be used where appropriate. When entering if name is different to racing name, please provide the following details (if known) (note: horse details can be checked on the Racing Australia website).
 - Racing name
 - Brands, colour and markings

- Microchip number
 - Life Number
 - Registration Certificate Number
 - Dam and Sire
 - Date horse retired
3. Riders to be 14 years and over on day of qualifying Show. Qualifying Shows must be affiliated with V.A.S. Ltd.
 4. Qualifying classes will be judged ridden.
 5. Once a qualifier has won, the horse cannot compete in any other qualifier competitions in that calendar year.
 6. All qualifying winners gain automatic entry into the Racing Victoria Off the Track Series Final to be held at the V.A.S. Ltd Saddle Horse Championships.
 7. To be judged as a good example of an Off the Track Thoroughbred, (rather than riding horse/hunter types), with the following being taken into consideration:
 - Thoroughbred qualities
 - Conformation
 - Manners, paces and performance
 - Injuries caused through racing such as blemishes are allowed
 9. Judge's decision is final in Qualifiers and Final.
 10. Qualifier Prizes: Sash, \$50 Prize Cheque sent out once qualification has been verified by Racing Victoria (Gift pack collected at State Final).

OFF THE TRACK FINAL

1. To have qualified at a Qualifying Show.
2. Horse to be entered in racing name where possible.
3. Expected to walk, trot and canter with change of rein. Competitors will be asked to do an individual workout and show walk, trot and canter on both reins finishing with a halt and salute to the judge/s.
4. Other regulations for Final
 - In the event of one rider going through to the Final with more than one horse they must nominate a substitute rider.
 - An exhibitor may not knowingly exhibit a horse that has been bred, sold, leased or produced by the judge and/or his/her employer.
 - An exhibitor may not show under a judge that is a member of his/her immediate family.
 - An exhibitor may not show under a judge that they have produced an equine for within the last 24 months.
5. Entry Fee – Refer to Saddlehorse entry form for fees.

State Prizes:

Winner - \$1000, Sash & Rug

Runner Up - \$500 & Sash, Final 8 – \$100, Sash and Racing Victoria Saddle Blanket.

Highest Placed Newcomer: To have had its last race within the last 2 years (from the date of the Final) \$500 & Sash

2021/22 OFF THE TRACK LED SERIES – QUALIFIER REGULATIONS

1. **Open to any thoroughbred horse bred to race that has been stud book registered, either domestically with the Australian Stud Book or Internationally that are 4 years and over and over 14.2 hands high.** Registrations will be checked by V.A.S. office.
2. Racing name to be used where appropriate. When entering if name is different to racing name, please provide the following details (if known)
 - Racing name
 - Microchip number
 - Life Number
 - Registration Certificate Number
 - Dam and Sire
 - Date horse retired
3. Qualifying Shows must be V.A.S. Ltd affiliated.
4. Qualifying classes will be judged led.
5. Once a qualifier has won, the horse cannot compete at another Show qualifier in that calendar year.
6. All qualifying winners gain automatic entry into the Racing Victoria Off the Track Led Series Final to be held at the V.A.S. Ltd Saddle Horse Championships.
7. To be judged as a good example of an Off the Track Thoroughbred, (rather than riding horse/hunter types), with the following being taken into consideration:
 - Thoroughbred qualities
 - Conformation
 - Manners, paces and performance
 - Injuries caused through racing such as blemishes are allowed
8. Judge's decision is Final in Qualifiers and Final.
9. Qualifier Prizes: Sash, \$50 Prize Cheque sent out once qualification has been verified by Racing Victoria (Gift pack collected at State Final).

HERO 2021/22 SERIES QUALIFIER REGULATIONS

1. **Open to all purebred freeze branded Standardbreds registered with Harness Racing Australia. Raced or unraced. Registrations will be verified.**
2. Registered/Racing name to be used where available. Freeze brand number must be provided.
3. Horse or Exhibitor do not need to be registered with any other Association or Breed Society other than Harness Racing Australia to be eligible to compete.
4. Riders to be aged 12 years and over on the day of the Qualifying Show.
5. Colts/Stallions are not permitted to contest a series qualifier.
6. Qualifying Shows must be V.A.S. Ltd affiliated.
7. Qualifying Classes will be judged ridden.
8. Once a qualifier has won, the horse cannot compete at another Show qualifier in that calendar year.
9. All Qualifying winners gain automatic entry into the HERO Series Final to be held at the V.A.S. Ltd Saddle Horse Championship.
10. To be judged as a good example of a Standardbred rather than a riding horse/hunter type with the following being taken into consideration:
 - Standardbred qualities
 - Conformation
 - Manners, paces and performance
 - Racing related injuries and/or blemishes are permitted
11. The Judge's Decision is final in the Qualifiers and Final.

Qualifier Prizes:

Sash, \$50 Prize Cheque sent out once qualification has been verified HERO Gift Pack (Gift Pack collected at State Final).

GENERAL SHOW REGULATIONS

- In the event of the judges failing to attend and adjudicate, the committee may appoint judges in their stead, who shall be deemed to be the judges originally appointed.
- Entries in writing must be lodged with the secretary at the Society's office by the closing date fixed in the prize schedule.
- The Committee reserves the absolute right to refuse admission to the ground of any exhibit for any reason seeming sufficient to the Committee, provided that an entry fee paid be refunded (if applicable). The owner or exhibitor of any exhibit disapproved of as an exhibit by the Committee of the Society must, immediately on notice to that effect, remove such exhibit from the Society's grounds. The Committee reserves the right of refusing or canceling any entry without giving reasons for doing so.
- No person may make any drawings or photographs of any exhibits without the written consent of the exhibitors.
- The judges may award a section prize instead of a first; or may withhold a prize altogether where, in their judgement, the quality of the exhibits so warrant.
- No prize shall be awarded by the judge for extra exhibits if the prize list contains a class or section in which the same can compete.
- The Committee may withhold any prize when mis-statements have erroneously or fraudulently been made regarding any exhibit, and exhibitors guilty of false entries or statements may be debarred from again exhibiting, and if members, will be liable to expulsion from the Society.
- Should any exhibitor having gained a prize be disqualified, the next on the list does not necessarily obtain the same prize. The Committee, with or without the advice of the judges, shall make all required awards.
- The Committee shall also have the power to require statutory declarations be made concerning any animals or article exhibited.
- All persons exhibiting shall accept the decision of the judges, and in the case of written protests or disputes as to the construction of any of these regulations, or the meaning of anything in the prize list, the decision of the Committee shall be accepted as final and without appeal.
- Protests must be lodged with a deposit of \$100 (which may be forfeited if considered frivolous) to the secretary in writing, on the day of competition.
- The privileges of distributing trade lists, advertisements, or other documents are restricted exclusively to exhibitors at their respective stands. Any infringement of this regulation will incur expulsion from the grounds.
- Every care will be taken of exhibits, but no responsibility will be incurred by the Society. The Society will not be responsible for any accident that may be caused through or by any exhibit, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Society harmless and indemnify it against any legal proceedings arising from such accident.
- The Committee may at any time for such reasons as may seem sufficient to it, waive in individual cases, or generally, compliance with the regulations
- or may extend or vary the times for doing anything fixed by the regulations or the prize schedule, either in individual cases or generally.
- In compiling this schedule, all care has been taken, but no responsibility will be incurred by the Society for omissions or misprints.

Prizes:

1st Prize sash, prize & \$100

2nd Prize sash & \$50

3rd Prize sash & \$25

Best Junior combination under 15 years on day of Show sash & \$50

Amateur Owner/Rider sash & \$50 sash

Sashes to 8th if at least 15 competitors

Rules and Regulations: One entry per rider (horse or pony does not need to be owned by the rider). Open to all competitors.

Attire: Smartest on Parade standard. Therefore exhibitors should pay particular attention to detail as points are awarded or deducted depending on correctness.

Gear: Riders may use a snaffle or double bridle. This event is open to all competitors. Three judges will judge the event & award points for the following categories.

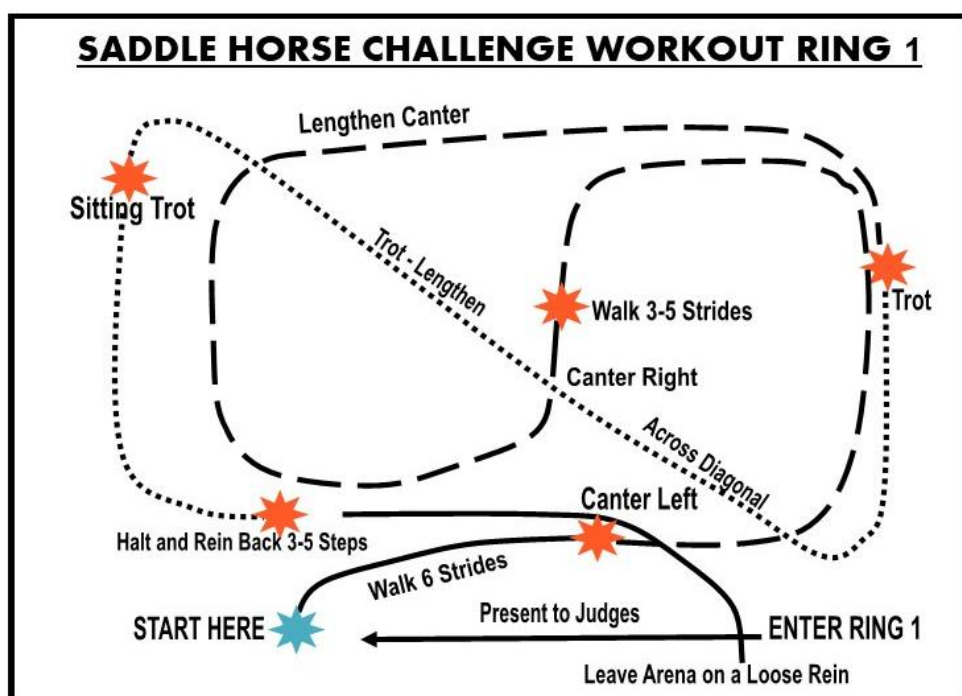
General appearance:

- Presentation of horse, rider & gear (20 points)
- Manners and Paces (30 points)
- Conformation and soundness (20 points)
- Workout (30 points)

The scores are then tallied with a possible score of 300 for the three judges results combined.

Competitors are required to present to the ring saddled for the presentation of sashes.

As this is a saddle-based event, in the event of a tie, the horse with the highest scoring workout will be deemed the winner.
