Fleeces to be in the hands of stewards no later than 5pm Thursday 17th March, unless otherwise arranged.

All fleeces will be judged on the following points system.

Trueness to type _____	10 points
Uniformity of Length _____	10 points
Soundness _____	10 points
Handle _____	10 points
Colour or Bloom _____	10 points
Character & Style _____	10 points
Evenness _____	10 points
Clean Fleece Wt. _____	30 points
TOTAL _____	100 points

Points Scale:

A fleece must not compete in more than one Class.

All fleeces to be skirted to suit the trade.

Fleeces which in the opinion of the judge are overgrown will be judged accordingly.

Place cards will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd in all classes.

Championship fleeces will be presented with a trophy and sash.

GROUP 1 FLEECE - STUDS

All fleeces will be micron tested and then placed in their respective class.

To be entered as Ram or Ewe.

Class 372 Superfine Ram Fleece 17.5 micron & finer

Class 373 Fine Ram Fleece 17.6 - 19 micron

Class 374 Medium Ram Fleece 19.1 - 21.5 micron

Class 375 Strong Ram Fleece 21.6 micron & stronger

Class 376 Purchased Stud Ram Fleece (*Must be purchased from a registered Merino Stud*)

Class 377 Superfine Ewe Fleece 17.5 micron & finer

Class 378 Fine Ewe Fleece 17.6 - 19.0 micron

Class 379 Medium Ewe Fleece 19.1 - 21.5 micron

Class 380 Strong Ewe Fleece 21.6 micron & stronger

Skirted fleeces of wool shorn by blades or machine off stud sheep and bred by owner, not including Class 376.

GROUP 2 FLEECE—COMMERCIAL

All fleeces will be micron tested and then placed in their respective class.

Class 381 Superfine Weaner Fleece 17.5 micron & finer

Class 382 Fine Weaner Fleece 17.6 - 19 micron

Class 383 Medium Weaner Fleece 19.1 - 21 micron

Class 384 Strong Weaner Fleece 21.1 micron & stronger

Class 385 Superfine Ewe or Wether Fleece 17.5 micron & finer

Class 386 Fine Ewe or Wether Fleece 17.6 -19.0 micron

Class 387 Medium Ewe or Wether Fleece 19.1 - 21 micron

Class 388 Strong Ewe or Wether Fleece 21.1 micron & stronger

Class 389 Merino Lambs Wool 1kg

Skirted fleeces of wool shorn by blades or machine. Must have been run under normal paddock conditions.

CONDITIONS:

1. Fleeces competing in Groups 1 & 2 are to be from Merino adult sheep over 2 years if entering as ram, ewe or wether, skirted and of 12 months maximum growth. If entering as a weaner, fleeces are to be from Merino sheep under 2 years and still displaying a weaners tip.
2. Any fleece which in the opinion of the judge has not been properly skirted will be judged accordingly.
3. All fleeces will be micron tested.
4. Fleeces will only be accepted from sheep which have been the bonafide property of the exhibitor for at least 6 months prior to being shorn.
