**Points Scale:** A fleece must not compete in more than one Class. All fleeces to be skirted to suit the trade. Fleeces which in the opinion of the judge are overgrown will be judged accordingly.

# **CONDITIONS:**

- Fleeces competing in Group 1 & 2 are to be from Merino adult sheep over 2 years if entering as ram, ewe or wether, skirted and of 12 months maximum growth. If entering as weaner, fleeces are to be from Merino sheep under 2 years.
- In Group 4, each fleece (numbered A,B,C) will be judged according to the scale of points set out below, giving a maximum total of 100 points per fleece. The three fleeces will then be judged as a group for evenness with 30 possible points awarded for this section. The maximum possible score per group is 330 points.
- Fleeces competing in Group 4 must be specially entered and not selected from those competing in other classes.

- Any fleece which in the opinion of the judge has not been properly skirted will be judged accordingly.
- All fleeces will be micron tested.
- Fleeces will only be accepted from sheep which have been the bonafide property of the exhibitor for at least 6 months prior to being shorn.

### **GROUP 1 FLEECE - STUD**

All fleeces will be micron tested and then placed in their respective class.

To be entered as Ram or Ewe.

Skirted fleeces of wool shorn by blades or machine off stud sheep and bred by owner, not including Class 605.

Must have been run under normal paddock conditions.

Class 602 Fine Ram Fleece 17.6 - 19 micron

Class 603 Medium Ram Fleece 19.1 - 21.5 micron

Class 604 Strong Ram Fleece 21.6 micron & stronger

Class 605 Purchased Stud Ram Fleece - (Must be purchased from a registered Merino Stud)

Class 606 Superfine Ewe Fleece 17.5 micron & finer
