Exhibits: Images must be emailed to entries@horshamshow.com.au to be collated in a visual presentation to be shown in Russell Hall on Show Day. All exhibits to be in colour unless specified 'black and white'.

Competition Location: Russell Hall next to The Cattle Shed pavilion.

Visual screen presentations of all entries will be in Russell Hall, in conjunction with the junior artwork submissions.

Prizes: All placegetters will have their photos printed and displayed in Russell Hall by the Horsham Agricultural Society. Competitors will be able to take their prints and be given prize cards for 1st, 2nd and 3rd. No prizemoney other than the aggregate prizes.

Aggregate Prizes

Best in Show Photo Exhibit: Prize/voucher to the value of \$50

Best Photo by a Local Photographer: Prize/voucher to the value of \$50

Advanced Photo Aggregate: Prize/voucher to the value of \$50

Open Aggregate: Prize/voucher to the value of \$50

Novice Aggregate: Prize/voucher to the value of \$50

Secondary Students Aggregate: Prize/voucher to the value of \$50

Primary Students Aggregate: Prize/voucher to the value of \$50

Scoring Aggregates: Three points for first, two points for second and one point for third. Highly commented awards will also be included if needed to separate a tie.

COMPETITION RULES

All photographs must be bona fide (own work) submitted to the Show Secretary via email at entries@horshamshow.com.au. This must be accompanied by your name and class number and the online entry form in another email as part of the entry process. The Horsham Show website has a link to the online entry process.

NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED

- Exhibitors may enter a maximum of three images in each section and must have been taken by the exhibitor. Smart phone images are accepted.
- Photographs submitted must not have previously taken a prize at the Horsham Show.
- A NOVICE is an entrant who has never won a prize at the Horsham Show.
- Photographers who have won two (2) NOVICE AGGREGATE AWARDS in previous Horsham Shows can only enter in the Open Classes or Advanced Photographer Classes.
- Photographers who have won two (2) OPEN CLASS AGGREGATE AWARDS in previous Horsham Shows, or have had an acceptance in an APS National, or a FIAP International Photographic Competition, can only enter the Advanced Photographer Classes.

Any Photographers who have won the aggregate in the Advanced section may continue to enter the advanced section only.

There are no specific sizes as this is an online competition.

AFTER THE SHOW

Winning exhibits may be collected after 7pm on show day or during the following week. Exhibits will not be kept after October 31st.

SPECIFIC DEFINITIONS

Local Sunset/Sunrise: Photo must have been taken at a location within 50km of Horsham.

Land, Sea or Waterscape: A picture of natural scenery, which may include people, buildings or man-made structures, provided these do not dominate the picture.

On the Farm: Any photo of farm life including sheep and other livestock, poultry, cropping, grazing, machinery or equipment.

Australian Bird: Doesn't have to be a bird native to Australia.

Other definitions of classes are self-explanatory.

VAS Junior Photography Competition - Animal/s In Action

The winner of this competition, will be judged at Wimmera group level in November, 2022.

Rules and Regulations

1. THEME FOR 2022/2023 – ANIMAL/S IN ACTION.
2. Exhibitors to be aged under 18 years on the day of their Local Show.
3. Unframed.

4. Print no larger than 20cm by 30cm.*
5. Must be mounted on thick card (mount no larger than 3cm).*
6. Professionals are not eligible, which is defined as someone that works professionally or derives the greater percentage of their income in that craft, art form or technique.
7. Each exhibit entered must be the bona fide work of the exhibitor.
8. All work is to have been completed in the last twelve (12) months prior to its entry at a local Show.
9. The competition follows the three levels of competition: Show Level, Group Level and State Level.
10. An exhibit having won at a Show will compete at the 2023 Group Final. The winning exhibit at the Group Final will then compete in the State Final at the 2023 Royal Melbourne Show.
11. An exhibitor having won at Show Level is not eligible to enter the VAS Photography competition at any other Show until after the Group Final judging.
12. An exhibitor is only eligible to represent one Group in the State Final.
13. If for any reason a winner is unable to compete at Group or State Final Level, then the second placegetter is eligible to compete.
14. An exhibit having won at State Final is no longer eligible to compete in the competition.
15. If an exhibitor is found to have won more than one Group Final the exhibitor must forfeit/refund all prizes and will be disqualified from exhibiting for 12 months.

(VAS) SENIOR PHOTOGRAPHY COMPETITION - Animal/s In Action: The winner of this competition, will be judged at Wimmera group level in November, 2022.

Rules and Regulations

1. THEME FOR 2022/2023 – ANIMAL/S IN ACTION.
2. Unframed.
3. Print no larger than 20cm by 30cm.*
4. Must be mounted on thick card (mount no larger than 3cm).*
5. Each exhibit entered must be the bona fide work of the exhibitor.
6. Professionals are not eligible, which is defined as someone that works professionally or derives the greater percentage of their income in that craft, art form or technique.
7. All work is to have been completed in the last twelve (12) months prior to its entry at a local Show.
8. The competition follows the three levels of competition: Show Level, Group Level and State Level.
9. An exhibit having won at a Show will compete at the 2023 Group Final. The winning exhibit at the Group Final will then compete in the State Final at the 2023 Royal Melbourne Show.
10. An exhibitor having won at Show Level is not eligible to enter the VAS Photography competition at any other Show until after the Group Final judging.
11. An exhibitor is only eligible to represent one Group in the State Final.
12. If for any reason a winner is unable to compete at Group or State Final Level, then the second placegetter is eligible to compete.
13. An exhibit having won at State Final is no longer eligible to compete in the competition.
14. If an exhibitor is found to have won more than one Group Final the exhibitor must forfeit/refund all prizes and will be disqualified from exhibiting for 12 months.
