WEDDINGS

IN THE CATTLE SHED AT THE MAYDALE RESERVE

Situated in the heart of Horsham overlooking the Wimmera River you'll find the Maydale Reserve, located within 19 hectares of the Horsham Showgrounds. This location is privately owned by the Horsham Agricultural Society who have opened up The Cattle Shed, Stable One, The Stockmen's Beer Garden for weddings.

As an events centre, the Maydale Reserve has the capacity to host weddings, expos, the annual agricultural show, conferences and festivals. Sometimes there's more than one event on at a time! But we work it out for everyone to retain their privacy as best as possible, when dates are important to both!



Its solid structure and crudely painted white posts and tin walls, with original raw timber trusses are what makes The Cattle Shed so appealing with its shabby style. A dirt floor, wooden trestles, white chairs and chandeliers makes for an interesting mix of eclectic decor.

THE CATTLE SHED

Perfectly suited for rusting weddings and special occasions, The Cattle Shed is the original cattle pavilion which was used at the Horsham Show



With a flat floor space of approximately 270sq2 (30m x 9m) and a large dance floor, the area can comfortably seat up to 110 guests. For cocktail style functions a mix of seating and standing can cater for up to 150 guests. Talk to us about installing temporary timber walls, if The Cattle Shed is too large for an intimate gathering.

Our base rate does not include any decorating but our onsite wedding coordinator, Jess has some awesome plans you can work with her on. She can also be your support on your wedding day.



For wedding hire, The Cattle Shed is yours for seven days from the Tuesday prior to your special day to the following Monday.

Included in the supply is one large (fridge size) esky in The Cattle Shed. We do not supply glasses. The hire includes white Americana chairs, tables (timber trestles or white melamine tables), pallet style cocktail tables, umbrellas (for outside use) and pallet style coffee tables. Table cloths are supplied but we request they be returned, laundered. Gas heaters are available in the cooler months, but the hirer is required to fill with gas at own cost. We have cool, commercial mist fans for the summer!

We can recommend a variety of suppliers, so please ask when you're thinking about flowers, catering, bands etc. In fact, we like to chat to the caterers before your wedding day.

Depending on your caterer, you may need to hire the Maydale Pavilion Kitchenette for them to plate up meals. This is an additional cost (see fee structure).



Included in the hire fee are unmatched coffee mugs and tea cups, an urn, disposable glasses, 200 dinner plates and eclectic style cutlery (no dessert bowls or bread & butter plates). Tea towels are available but must be returned laundered by the hirer.

Garbage bins are provided and as part of the pack up, need to be lined up outside The Cattle Shed for council collection. The venue must be left the way it is found. Toilet facilities and supplies are included in the hire price.

In keeping with the EPA guidelines, all noise must cease by 11pm Friday and Saturday nights. Other nights, 10pm.

THE STOCKMEN'S BEER GARDEN



The Poultry Shed in the Stockmen's Beer Garden makes for a stunning rustic location for a wedding ceremony.

Looking over the Wimmera River there are also unique places suitable to hire for ceremonies.

Included in the fee structure are white chairs or rustic pews and shade umbrellas. The timber arbour is included in the price and can be relocated within the beer garden only.

Large A frame arbours are also available to hire POA.





SEELIGER'S BAR

Located within the Stockmen's Beer Garden is Seeliger's Bar which is a former horse wash!

With power and lighting, a fridge can be supplied enabling it to be used for pre-dinner drinks and canapes. All catering on the property is BYO. You do not need a licence to bring your own alcohol or food for catering.

Opportunities abound for photography. Whether it's the big reveal and photos prior to your ceremony or photos between the ceremony and reception, there are so many stunning locations on site. Whether it's in our 80 year old stables or somewhere on the riverbank.

And finally, your guests who have travelled to attend your special occasion are welcome to camp under the canopy of stars. With powered and unpowered sites, we have showers available for their use. If camping is required, once your booking has been secured, we can send you the link for camp site bookings. Restrictions around campfires need to be complied with. We can supply fire drums at an additional cost if required.
