Dinner Under the Stars

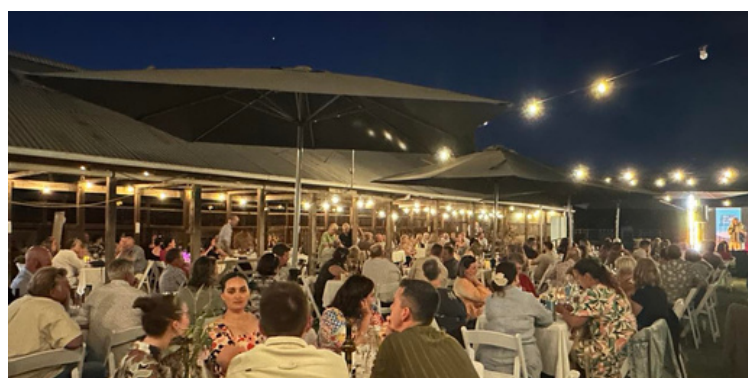
