Exhibit Sizes

All prints must be 5"x7" (12.5cm x 17.5cm) except for 'Animal Portraits' which need to be 8"x12" (20cm x 30cm). All photos must be mounted, mount border no larger than 4cm.

Entrants can submit up to 3 photos per class.

Competition Rules

Exhibits must have the entry card attached to the front of the mount and the exhibitor's name & number on the back.

Any photographs of children must have a signed release fixed to the back of the mount, "I.....(parent/guardian) give permission for this image of(child's name) to be displayed in a public exhibition.

Exhibitors may enter a maximum of three prints in each section and the original image must be the bona fide work of the exhibitor using a camera, iPad or smart phone in listed categories.

Photographs submitted must not have previously taken a prize at the Horsham Show.

After the show – collection and prizes

Exhibitors may collect their prints and/or prize cards by calling into the show office on the Monday after the show (29th September) from 9am. The Office will be open for collection for one week only. The photos will then be destroyed. On collection the exhibitors must present their duplicate exhibit cards to identify their print.

ALL PRIZE MONEY can be collected from the Show Secretary's Office after 4.30 p.m. on Show Day, September 28th.
