<u>Facility Terms and Conditions</u>

Facility use outside the following terms and conditions deems unauthorised access to Maydale Reserve - Horsham Showgrounds and the Horsham Agricultural Society reserves the right to request users to vacate the premises, without further consultation.

It is compulsory for all users of the Maydale Reserve - Horsham Showgrounds facilities (stables & camping) to have a membership/facility \$15 fee per exhibit. It is compulsory for all visitors with horses (those not participating but familiarising their horses) to pay facility fee of \$15. Access to stabling and camping, can be limited outside of show season.

Show Facility fee \$15 per exhibit.

Flat rate \$20 per horse, all classes. Includes swabbing fee.

Saddle Horse Challenge \$25 per horse.

Topsy Ring \$10 per competitor

Please note: NO PRE-ALLOCATION OF STABLES. The Horsham Agricultural Society reserves the right to retain bond monies \$33 for boxes left unclean. A limited number of stallion boxes are available for use, but priority is given to stallions.

- \$33.00 compulsory bond per stable cleaning deposit. This money is refunded once the stable has been checked off by a Horsham Ag Society staff member.
- Camping is charged at \$33.00 per night (powered site) or

This Show will be conducted strictly under EA & VAS rules. Competitors in all classes are to be suitably attired. Prize winners must leave the ring, as directed, after receiving awards.

REGULATIONS

(to be read in conjunction with Terms and Conditions and General Show Regulations)

- Entries will only be received subject to the rules and regulations of the Society
 and the decisions of the Committee. All exhibits must be a bona fide property
 of the exhibitor or held by the exhibitor under a written lease recognised by
 the Society at the time of entry.
- 2. Every exhibitor or competitor shall be bound by and observe the decisions and directions of the Society.
- 3. The Society reserves the right to reject at any time any entry or prohibit any persons or animals from competition in any class.
- 4. The Society's Veterinary Surgeon's decision regarding age shall be final.
- 5. No ribbons will be permitted on exhibitors except those won during the show.

- 6. Owners entering their horses or ponies do so entirely at their own risk and it is a condition of entry that no liability of any kind attaches itself to the Society, its officials or members in any respect whatsoever, other than the liability for refund of entry fee in the event of abandonment of any competitions.
- 7. All events to be held and run over courses and obstacles as the Society may decide.
- 8. Animals must be haltered in the ring.
- 9. EA random swabbing procedures may be imposed by the Society and also reserves the right to scan for microchip proof of identity of any exhibit. A \$3 swabbing fee per horse entry will be included in the entry fee.
- 10. Exhibits must be exhibited as Open or Show Hunters not both competitors contravening this rule will be eliminated.
- 11. Protests **to be lodged with deposit of \$100,** in writing, to the show office. NO OTHER FORM OF PROTESTS WILL BE CONSIDERED
- 12. Refunds will not be given for scratching's unless a valid Veterinary (horse) or Medical Certificate is provided within 7 days of the show and will only be given less an administration fee of \$10.

General Show Regulations

- This Horse Show is conducted under EA & VAS (Victorian Agricultural Shows)
 rules. Please read the Horse Competition Exhibitor Handbook: <u>VAS Horse</u>
 Competition Exhibitor Handbook
- 2. Entries On The Day to be paid in cash or via EFT to The Secretary's Tent before classes commence in the Rings.
- In the event of the judges failing to attend and adjudicate, the committee
 may appoint judges in their stead, who shall be deemed to be the judges
 originally appointed.
- 4. The Committee reserves the absolute right to refuse admission to the ground of any exhibit for any reason seeming sufficient to the Committee, provided that an entry fee paid be refunded (if applicable). The owner or exhibitor of any exhibit disapproved of as an exhibit by the Committee of the Society

- must, immediately on notice to that effect, remove such exhibit from the Society's grounds. The Committee reserves the right of refusing or cancelling any entry without giving reasons for doing so.
- 5. By attending this event, you can be expected to have your photo taken without consent, unless you contact the ringmaster.
- 6. The judges may award a section prize instead of a first; or may withhold a prize altogether where, in their judgement, the quality of the exhibits so warrant.
- 7. No prize shall be awarded by the judge for extra exhibits if the prize list contains a class or section in which the same can compete.
- 8. The Committee may withhold any prize when misstatements have erroneously or fraudulently been made regarding any exhibit, and exhibitors guilty of false entries or statements may be debarred from again exhibiting, and if members, will be liable to expulsion from the Society.
- 9. Should any exhibitor having gained a prize be disqualified, the next on the list does not necessarily obtain the same prize. The Committee, with or without the advice of the judges, shall make all required awards.
- 10. The Committee shall also have the power to require statutory declarations be made concerning any animals or article exhibited.
- 11. All persons exhibiting shall accept the decision of the judges, and in the case of written protests or disputes as to the construction of any of these regulations, or the meaning of anything in the prize list, the decision of the Committee shall be accepted as final and without appeal.
- 12. Protests must be lodged with a deposit of \$100 (which may be forfeited if considered frivolous) to the secretary tent in writing, on the day of competition.
- 13. The privileges of distributing trade lists, advertisements, or other documents are restricted exclusively to exhibitors at their respective stands. Any infringement of this regulation will incur expulsion from the grounds.
- 14. Every care will be taken of exhibits, but no responsibility will be incurred by the Society. The Society will not be responsible for any accident that may be

caused through or by any exhibit, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Society harmless and indemnify it against any legal proceedings arising from such accident. • The Committee may at any time for such reasons as may seem sufficient to it, waive in individual cases, or generally, compliance with the regulations

- 15. Or may extend or vary the times for doing anything fixed by the regulations or the prize schedule, either in individual cases or generally.
- 16. In compiling this schedule, all care has been taken, but no responsibility will be incurred by the Society for omissions or misprints. It is subject to change without notice.

Code of Conduct - Competitors & Officials (VAS Guidance)

- 1. Respect and fairness: Stewards, judges, and officials must treat all competitors with courtesy, fairness, and professionalism at all times.
- 2. Competitor behaviour: Competitors must respect the authority of stewards and volunteers, acknowledging their role in running the show.
- 3. Unacceptable conduct: Abusive language, false claims, or deliberately misleading statements about judges, stewards, or volunteers are not tolerated and may result in disciplinary action.
- 4. Grievances: Competitors who feel they have been treated unfairly must lodge a formal protest on the day, accompanied by a \$100 fee. The matter will be considered by the Ringmaster, Judge, and Chief Steward. Until the protest is resolved, the competitor must not enter the ring. If the matter cannot be settled, they may be asked to leave the grounds.
- 5. Positive environment: Both competitors and officials share responsibility for creating a safe, enjoyable, and fair competition environment.

GOOD HANDS CHALLENGE TROPHY

Open to girls and boys aged 10 years and under 15 years on the day of the Local Show Rules & Regulations – Local Show

- 1. The VAS Good Hands Challenge Trophy is conducted at the VAS Saddle Horse Championships.
- 2. The VAS Good Hands Challenge Trophy is open to boys and girls aged 10 years and under 15 years on the day of the Local Show.
- 3. All VAS Affiliated Shows are invited to hold the qualifying competitions. Show societies are encouraged to run one class at the Local Show which includes girls and boys.
- 4. The competitors shall be judged solely on their riding ability mount, saddlery or costume will not be taken into account.
- 5. Special attention will be paid to hands and seat, general management and control of the horse or pony.
- 6. Competitors must ride using an ordinary snaffle, single jointed in the centre. The mouthpiece must be smooth and made of the same type of metal, with or without a cavesson on the noseband.
- 7. A gear check may take place.
- 8. 8. Please note straight bar snaffle, drop nosebands, whips and spurs are not allowed.

ALABAR HERO SERIES

Class 2005 Alabar Hero Series in Ring 3

- 1. Open to all purebred freeze branded or microchipped Standardbreds registered with Harness Racing Australia. Raced or unraced. Registrations will be verified.
- 2. Registered/Racing name to be used where available. Freeze brand number or microchip number must be provided.
- 3. Horse does not need to be registered with any other Association or Breed Society other than Harness Racing Australia to be eligible to compete.
- 4. Riders to be aged 12 years and over on the day of the Qualifying Show.
- 5. Colts/Stallions are not permitted to contest a series qualifier.
- 6. Qualifying Shows must be VAS Ltd affiliated.
- 7. Qualifying classes will be judged ridden.
- 8. Once a horse has won a qualifier, the horse cannot compete at another Show qualifier in that calendar year.
- 9. All qualifying winners gain automatic entry into the Alabar HERO Series Final to be held at the VAS Ltd Saddle Horse Championships.
- 10. To be judged as a good example of a Standardbred rather than a riding horse/hunter type with the following being taken into consideration:
 - a. Standardbred qualities
 - b. Conformation
 - c. Manners, paces and performance
 - d. Racing related injuries and/or blemishes are permitted
- 11. The Judge's Decision is Final in the Qualifiers and State Final.
- 12. Qualifier Prizes: Sash, \$50.00 Prizemoney sent out once qualification has been verified and HERO Gift Pack (Prize Pack collected at State Final).

Gear: Riders may use a snaffle or double bridle. This event is open to all competitors. The judges will judge the event & award points for the following categories.


General appearance:

- Workout (30 points)


Scores

1. The scores are then tallied with a possible score of 200 for the two judges' results combined.

- 1. Stand and present to judge
- 2. Walk out, circle left 1/2 circle in rising trot
- 3. Change direction through centre
- 4. Right circle in rising trot
- 5. Lengthen trot along side, then into canter at corner
- 6. Canter 1/2 circle
- 7. Simple change through centre
- 8. Canter 1/2 circle left
- 9. Return to trot
- 10. Walk and halt at judge



- 2. Competitors are required to present to the ring saddled for the presentation of sashes.
- 3. As this is a saddle-based event, in the event of a tie, the horse with the highest scoring workout will be deemed the winner.
